#### Personal encounters pay off #fbm23 – in its anniversary year, Frankfurter Buchmesse continues to proves its uniquely international role

The 75th Frankfurter Buchmesse (18 – 22 October 2023) has once again demonstrated its unique role as the most important international meeting place for the book and media industry. There was a significant growth spurt on both the trade visitor and general public days. As a kind of anniversary present, the record occupancy of the Literary Agents & Scouts Centre (LitAg), which was booked out early, gave the book fair its best year ever.

Behind the figures is a realisation: what really counts is personal encounters. Obviously, this is even more true in times of war and crisis. Economic and normative uncertainties increase the need for dialogue and debate. The defence of the freedom of the word, the core brand of the Frankfurter Buchmesse, becomes ever more important in such times. The political significance of of the Frankfurter Buchmesse has therefore also increased. This is reflected in the high level of international media interest with more than 7,000 accredited media representatives. The old rule applies here: "interest follows relevance."



#### Survey of exhibiting companies<sup>1</sup> and trade visitors<sup>2</sup>


How satisfied were you with the programme of Frankfurter Buchmesse 2023 overall?



#### Literary Agents & Scouts Centre (LitAg)

#### **Publishing Perspectives Forum**

Over two and a half days, visitors were able to experience an exciting professional programme, such as mini-conferences on the topics of Audio, Kids and Scholarly publishing.

#### International Translation Centre

The central stage for everything to do with translation with five days of professional and public programmes, jointly organised by Germany's association of Germanlanguage translators (VdÜ) and the Frankfurter Buchmesse. On **200 square metres**, it offered its own stage and a networking space for exchange between **literary translators, publishers, authors, scouts and agents**.<sup>4</sup>







#### Guest of Honour 2023: Slovenia

#### **Authors & New Releases**

In Slovenia's year as Guest of Honour, 118 new publications from 63 publishing houses appeared on the German-language book market, including translations by Slovenian authors and books about Slovenia. 76 translations were sponsored by the Slovenian book agency JAK as part of the Guest of Honour presentation.

Around 75 authors, poets, philosophers and translators from Slovenia travelled to Frankfurter Buchmesse in 2023 to take part in five days of literary discussions, professional encounters, workshops and performances at the book fair.



#### At the fair

With the slogan "Honeycomb of Words", visitors to the fair were invited to go on a lyrical journey of discovery through Slovenia's nature in the 2,300 square metre Guest of Honour Pavilion. There, the international book exhibition "Books on Slovenia" presented over **400 titles** from **130 publishers** from **30 countries** and in **27 languages**. In addition to an exhibition of Slovenian illustrators, more than **30 exhibitors** from Slovenia presented their works on a total area of 284 square metres.

#### Programme

More than 200 literary and cultural events were registered in autumn 2023 for Guest of Honour Slovenia in the Frankfurt Buchmesse Calendar of Events, including more than 70 events at the fair.

In addition to the events on the exhibition grounds, there was a diverse programme of around 140 events in the city of Frankfurt, including exhibitions, poetry events, performances and readings. Guest of Honour 2024: Italy
