FBM director Juergen Boos condemns the terrorist attack on Israel | Guest of Honour: poetry in focus | Democracy Fair: political discussions with various authors and activists | New “Literature Stage” from ARD, ZDF and 3sat | Diverse anniversary events in the city | Slovenian President Nataša Pirc Musar to speak at opening ceremony

In its anniversary year, the 75th Frankfurter Buchmesse (18–22 October 2023) will offer a high-profile programme of cultural and political events – as a forum for literature and social debate. The publishing industry’s largest gathering will be opened today, Tuesday, 17 October, by the President of the Republic of Slovenia Nataša Pirc Musar. Author and philosopher Slavoj Žižek and poet and journalist Miljana Cunta will give philosophical and literary keynote addresses at the opening ceremony. The Mayor of the City of Frankfurt, Mike Josef, the State of Hesse’s Minister of State for Science and the Arts, Angela Dorn, and the Chairwoman of the German Publishers & Booksellers Association, Karin Schmidt-Friderichs, will also speak.

“The world is coming undone,” said Juergen Boos, Director of Frankfurter Buchmesse, at today’s press conference, commenting on a globe unsettled by simultaneous crises. “We have the crisis of climate change and the crisis among Western democracies. We have been experiencing Putin’s war of aggression against Ukraine for over a year and a half. And on 7 October, Hamas’s terrorist warfare against Israel reached a whole new, terrifying level. We are all horrified. Frankfurter Buchmesse has always been about humanity; the focus is on people interacting with each other. This humanity was shattered on 7 October by the attack on Israel carried out by Hamas’s terrorists. Our sympathy goes out to the people whose loved ones have been the targets of this violence and everyone in Israel and Palestine suffering because of this war. We condemn the terror against Israel and condemn those who are financing it and thus making it possible.”

Over the five days of the fair, numerous events will explore today’s most pressing socio-political issues. As the guest speaker at the opening press conference, British science journalist and author Gaia Vince (*Nomad Century*) shed light on the connection between climate change and the global migrant flows that have already begun. On the main cultural policy stage in the iconic Frankfurt Pavilion, participants in upcoming discussions will include Claudia Roth, (Germany’s Federal Commissioner for Culture and the Media), Deniz Yücel (PEN Berlin), Irina Sherbakova

(author and cofounder of the human rights organisation Memorial.), Dmitry Glukhovsky (Russian bestselling author in exile) and Meron Mendel (Bildungsstätte Anne Frank).

On the Frankfurt International Stage, experts from the United Nations will discuss the topic of climate change and encourage people to move from analysis to action, in keeping with the event's title: "The Era of Global Boiling – What Can We Do?" Climate activist and cofounder of the Last Generation movement, Lea Bonasera, will also be present in Frankfurt. Along with other activists, she will be participating in the programme "SHEROES – Streiterinnen für die Zukunft" (SHEROES – Fighters for the Future) on the Literature Stage hosted by broadcasters ARD, ZDF and 3sat. Other authors invited to appear this year include former Femen activist Zana Ramadani and AI expert Mina Saidze.

Fans of good stories and literary live encounters can look forward to multiple highlights at the 2023 fair. In the Frankfurt Audio area, which showcases audiobooks and podcasts, many well-known voices will be heard, such as Rufus Beck (*Harry Potter*) and Marc-Uwe Kling (*Kangaroo Chronicles*). For the first time, the very popular German political podcast Lage der Nation (State of the Nation) will make an appearance at the book fair, in Harmony Hall at the Congress Center (CMF). During "Lage Live", Philip Banse and Ulf Buermeyer will record a new episode of their successful podcast before an audience of some 2,000 people. A Literary Gala, curated by ARD, ZDF and 3sat, will also be held in the CMF and will feature Christopher Clark, Lizzie Doron, Cornelia Funke, Amir Gudarzi and Thomas Hettche. The recipient of this year's Peace Prize of the German Book Trade, Salman Rushdie, has also confirmed he will participate in the gala. Every day from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm, the latest literary developments will be presented on the Literature Stage hosted by ARD, ZDF and 3sat. Moderators Bärbel Schäfer, Denis Scheck, Knut Cordsen, Mona Ameziane, Thea Dorn, Katty Salié, Jo Schück, Vivian Perkovic, Gert Scobel and others will take the opportunity to converse with illustrious authors.

From Friday to Sunday on various stages across the fairgrounds, the Frankfurt Kids Festival will bring together renowned names from the world of children's and young adult literature. Among the stars who have announced they will participate are Margit Auer and Cornelia Funke, along with Benjamin Lacombe and Ursula Poznanski. Otfried Preußler's birthday (he would have turned 100 on 20 October 2023) will also be duly celebrated. With so many literary celebrities present, book signings are a must: the Meet the Author area in Hall 4.1 is a new event location that makes it possible for authors and fans to interact in an informal setting.

The team organising Slovenia's appearance as Guest of Honour has promised a great show for this year's fair. Some 75 authors and creatives will make up the delegation from the country that has only existed as an independent state for 32 years. In addition, there will be more than 30 publishers and institutions, an illustrators' exhibition and a wide-ranging programme of more than 70 events at the Guest of Honour Pavilion. Among the highlights there will be a talk between Juergen Boos, Director of Frankfurter Buchmesse, and Aleksander Čeferin, President of the UEFA football organisation. In terms of literature, poetry will be the focus of Slovenia's appearance at the fair, which will take place under the motto "Honeycomb of Words". The Guest

of Honour programme will also have a second focus: philosophy. One much anticipated event is the specialist programme curated by publishing scholar Miha Kovač, which will take an interdisciplinary look at the topic “Higher-Level Reading”. A cultural high point in the Guest of Honour programme will be the concert by Slovenia’s most famous band, Laibach, which will perform “Alamut – Historical Symphony” in the Jahrhunderthalle. The intercultural work is based on the 1938 novel by Vladimir Bartol.

To mark its 75th anniversary, Frankfurter Buchmesse has organised special events that both put the spotlight on itself and include Frankfurt’s residents in the celebration of “their” book fair. Using the tagline “And the story goes on”, the campaign features reminiscences of the fair’s historic milestones and a preview of coming chapters. Different motifs have been appearing in a variety of forms throughout the city in recent weeks. Advertising on buses and at bus stops across Frankfurt address expected visitors and passers-by, while messages at the airport and the main train station greet arriving passengers. Since the end of September, 75 of the city’s public bookcases have been adorned with this year’s FBM logo.

And the story goes on: Frankfurter Buchmesse and the City of Frankfurt make the 75th anniversary visible across the entire city area**Campaign: 75 chairs – 75 stories | 75 bookcases bear the anniversary design**

In 2023, Frankfurter Buchmesse will celebrate its 75th anniversary. A reason to bring its eventful history to life once again and at the same time look expectantly to the future: under the motto "And the story goes on", the anniversary campaign - which was developed together with the Frankfurt creative agency Vier für Texas - combines the memory of historical milestones with an outlook on the next chapters. To mark the occasion, Frankfurter Buchmesse has teamed up with the City of Frankfurt to bring the history of the fair into the present and make it a tangible experience beyond the exhibition grounds. The anniversary activities in Frankfurt's city centre are sponsored by the City of Frankfurt and take place in close cooperation with City Marketing.

"Frankfurter Buchmesse and the City of Frankfurt are natural allies. We have, historically, established a very close connection. What began in 1949 as a small book show in Frankfurt's Paulskirche – with the participation of 205 German publishing companies – has established itself over the decades as the largest international book fair in Frankfurt. Every October, the world looks to Frankfurt when authors, publishing professionals, rights and licencing dealers, as well as high-ranking guests from the worlds of culture, politics and business from over 100 countries, come to Frankfurt. So basically, we are celebrating a joint 75th anniversary!", says Juergen Boos, Director of Frankfurter Buchmesse, about this cooperation.

"Every year in October, the international book fair makes Frankfurt the world capital of books, a global centre of cultural attention. On the occasion of its 75th anniversary, it shows itself in even greater splendour. I am very happy that the fair has overcome the COVID years and is thus once again ensuring literary life, outside the fairgrounds, in the city. This is Frankfurt's fifth season of the year", says Dr. Ina Hartwig, Head of the Department of Culture and Science of the City of Frankfurt am Main.

Stephanie Wüst, Head of the Economic Affairs Department of the City of Frankfurt and Chairwoman of the Supervisory Board of Messe Frankfurt, says: "Frankfurter Buchmesse is a flagship for our city and makes us proud. It transports Frankfurt's great past and present publishers, and authors, into the future. Above all, however, the book fair sets an example for diversity and freedom of opinion that is perceptible all over the world. The 75 people who have told their stories about Frankfurt and the book fair in this anniversary year bear witness to this. Frankfurt citizens and more than 300,000 visitors to the fair will be able to listen in on these stories on 16 October on Paulsplatz, and later on the fairgrounds, and find out what significance their Frankfurter Buchmesse has had on the rest of the world. I am particularly pleased that with this great project - and several others - we have succeeded in emphasising the close connection



between the city and Frankfurter Buchmesse. I was therefore happy to support the 75 Chairs - 75 Stories project with City Marketing."

Over the next few weeks, the anniversary of Frankfurter Buchmesse will be visible throughout the city via a variety of activities and advertising measures.

Campaign on Paulsplatz and the exhibition grounds: 75 chairs – 75 stories

"Without Frankfurter Buchmesse and without books, my life would not have been so wonderful," says Michel Friedman, a lawyer, publicist and philosopher living in Frankfurt am Main. This formative sentence is only a small excerpt of what lies behind the "75 chairs – 75 stories" campaign. On 16 October, Paulsplatz – where the first book fair was held in 1949 – had been transformed into a place of stories: From 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., 75 chairs were distributed on the square. They led via individual QR codes to personal stories of 75 very different people and their connection with Frankfurter Buchmesse. The storytellers include well-known names as well as visitors and international book fair friends, but also people who are more active behind the scenes of the fair. From 17 to 22 October, those 75 chairs are placed on the Agora.

Bookcases bear the anniversary design

75 bookcases in the city bear the Frankfurter Buchmesse anniversary design. Over the past few weeks, surprises were added to them. Until today, admission tickets and other prizes were hidden there. Clues about this campaign were shared via the social media channels of Frankfurter Buchmesse and of the City of Frankfurt.

Classic advertising campaigns in the city

The campaign's history-conscious and future-oriented approach is also reflected in the numerous advertising initiatives: From large posters in the city and megalights on public info screens, the campaign's motifs will be played out in a variety of advertising formats: Advertising spaces on buses and train stations will attract potential visitors and passers-by throughout the city, while positioning at the airport and main train station will welcome arriving passengers.

Aldus Up Stage in Hall 4.1

Aldus Up is the follow-up project to Aldus, the network of European book fairs. It links more than 20 European trade shows – including Frankfurter Buchmesse, London Book Fair, Buch Wien and Bologna Children's Book Fair – in order to promote internationalisation, research and innovation in the book market. This large-scale cooperation project is co-funded by the Creative Europe Programme of the European Union.

The new Aldus Up Stage in Hall 4.1 will host events on industry topics ranging from education, inclusion and sustainability to translation funding, licensing, digitalisation, AI and VR. The weekend programme focuses on education and book presentations.

Anniversary Area in foyer of Hall 4.1 – with Congratulations Wall, Selfie Point and book tips

Frankfurter Buchmesse will be celebrating its 75th edition together with guests from all around the world. Before language experts discuss vocabulary and today's changing youth culture, a video will be shown presenting the Top 10 German words used by young people in 2023. At the end of the event on Sunday, the Young People's Word of the Year for 2023 will be revealed.

First joint appearance: ARD, ZDF and 3sat at Frankfurter Buchmesse

For the first time, broadcasters ARD, ZDF and 3sat are organising a joint “literature stage” at Frankfurter Buchmesse. The stage’s programme of events will take place daily from 18 to 22 October, from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. The cultural offerings will be broadcast live and will be available on demand in the three partners’ media centres and audio libraries, and on their websites and social media channels. The livestream of events can be accessed at ardkultur.de, buchmesse.zdf.de and 3sat.de. ARD Kultur will also be offering highlights as video-on-demand and audio recordings. Articles and reports will appear in the broadcasters’ magazines and on cultural shows, such as ZDF’s “aspekte” and “Das Literarische Quartett”, 3sat’s “Buchzeit”, its “Kulturzeit” magazine, ARD’s culture magazine “tnt – titel, thesen, temperamente” and hr television’s “hauptsache kultur”. ARD’s cultural programmes on the radio and in its audio library will also feature a multifaceted programme covering the events taking place on the literary stage. The stage’s motto is “Your Book. The Best of Frankfurter Buchmesse 2023 on the Literature Stage from ARD, ZDF and 3sat”, which is also the title of jointly produced TV programme featuring highlights from the fair.

ARTE documentary: “Geist, Geschäft und Party – 75. Frankfurter Buchmesse” (ARTE/ZDF 2023)

To mark Frankfurter Buchmesse’s 75th anniversary, broadcaster ARTE has put together a documentary about the history of the most exciting, exhausting and important week of the year when it comes to books. The film “Geist, Geschäft und Party – 75. Frankfurter Buchmesse” (Minds, Business Deals and Parties – The 75th Frankfurter Buchmesse) by director Jobst Knigge is about war and new beginnings, literature that breaks down walls, death threats, protests and bestsellers, readings and parties, the joys of diving into a book, and why Frankfurt is so important for all of the above. The director of Frankfurt Buchmesse, Juergen Boos, talks about what a typical day is like. Publishers such as Michael Krüger, Antoine Gallimard and Felicitas von Lovenberg have their say, as does the Danish bestselling author Jussi Adler Olsen and many others.

Comics Centre in Hall 6.1

This year, 14 publishers will be exhibiting in the new international Comics Centre. Other comics publishers, such as KOCCA, IDW and Panini, will have their own stands nearby. The centre's programming begins on Wednesday with a guided tour of the international comics publishers, including a welcome talk in the Illustrators Corner. The tour will conclude with an invitation to attend the opening of the Comics Centre at 5:00 pm. Other events being held at various locations across the fairgrounds will include signing sessions with international illustrators, tours for trade visitors, a comics matinee, a comics-to-screen matchmaking service and a weekend programme.

Education Forum with weekend programme under the patronage of Germany's education ministers | Kulturstadion in Hall 4.1

For the first time, Germany's Standing Conference of the Ministers of Education and Cultural Affairs will serve as patron for the Education Forum (3.1 D12) and its events on learning and teaching. In addition, Frankfurter Buchmesse's partnership with the educational association Bildungsmedien e.V. has been expanded: the association will now also be organising the weekend programme for the general public. Litcam's "Kulturstadion", which previously used the Education Forum to showcase its events at the weekend, is moving to the Aldus Up Stage. That's where visitors can enjoy Kulturstadion's colourful programme of events related to literature, football and society – which, this year, will also take a look at the 2024 European Football Championship. www.buchmesse.de/forum-bildung; www.litcam.de/de/kulturstadion

EU project: S+T+ARTS Day 2023 – Projects at the intersection of art and technology

This year, Frankfurter Buchmesse will again be a partner for the S+T+ARTS Prize and will host S+T+ARTS Day. Beforehand, on Wednesday, 18 October, the S+T+ARTS Prize community event "Exploring New Horizons" will take place on the Aldus Up Stage in Hall 4.1, in cooperation with the B3 Festival of the Moving Image. As part of S+T+ARTS Day on Friday, 20 October, various panel discussions will examine topics related to AI, VR, humans and the environment. Information on S+T+ARTS Day and on individual projects will be presented at stand H75 in Hall 4.1. The S+T+ARTS Prize is an initiative of the European Commission and is designed to explore the interplay of technology and artistic practice. The focus is on people and projects that can help overcome Europe's social, ecological and economic challenges. This initiative has

received funding from the European's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme.

Focus on artificial intelligence

The trending topic of artificial intelligence will be hotly debated at the fair – from practical experiences with AI-supported translation tools to copyright issues. Numerous speakers will be appearing on various stages, including “Forbes 30 under 30” founder Mina Saidze, linguist Naomi Baron, Shimmr AI CEO Nadim Sadek and copyright law expert Ursula Feindor-Schmidt. Focus topic: Democracy and Human Rights

Organised together with Germany's Federal Foreign Office, the Frankfurt Forum will take place in the Frankfurt Pavilion, the book fair's stage for cultural policy issues. This year, the focus will be on democracy and human rights. In addition, Frankfurter Buchmesse will again be cooperating with the United Nations in the year that marks both its own anniversary and that of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which is also turning 75. At the fair's opening on Wednesday, international authors will gather in the Frankfurt Studio to read selected articles from the declaration in their native languages.

Frankfurt Audio: New stage with public programme

At the weekend (21–22 October 2023), the Audio Business Lounge will be transformed into the World of Audiobooks Stage – powered by Bookwire (Hall 3.1 J25). In addition to award-winning audiobook narrator and actor Rufus Beck and actor and narrator Steffen Groth, many other authors will be participating, such as Jan Weiler, Lilly Lucas and Susanne Fröhlich. **“Honeycomb of Words” – Guest of Honour Slovenia
Slovenia presents its literature and culture in Frankfurt**

This year’s Guest of Honour, Slovenia, will be presenting its literary and cultural landscape at the 75th Frankfurter Buchmesse under the motto “Honeycomb of Words”. Drago Jančar, Miljana Cunta, Aleš Šteger, Slavoj Žižek, Ana Marwan, Mojca Kumerdej, Goran Vojnović and many more: some 75 Slovenian authors, poets, philosophers and translators will be travelling to Frankfurt. In addition to poetry and philosophy, Slovenia’s appearance as Guest of Honour will focus on the country’s close connection to nature. Numerous exhibitions and events in the city will turn the Guest of Honour programme into a memorable experience even beyond the fairgrounds. Over 100 books have been translated since mid-2022 as part of the Guest of Honour programme for bringing Slovenian publications to the German-language market; 50 of them received funding from translation programmes.

“I’m very impressed by the programme that the Slovenian Guest of Honour team has organised,” says Juergen Boos, Director of Frankfurter Buchmesse. “In addition to talks with the country’s best-known authors of fiction and nonfiction, we’ll be inspired in Frankfurt by Slovenian poetry, listen to philosophic and scientific debates and learn more about the importance of sustainability and sports in Slovenian culture. Connections to the global publishing industry will already be apparent at the Guest of Honour Pavilion, when actors from the guest country enter into discussions with international authors and experts on the pavilion’s stages. With the Ljubljana Reading Manifesto, Slovenia is also the first Guest of Honour to put a special focus on scientific topics.”

Miljana Cunta and Slavoj Žižek to speak at the opening ceremony

Slavoj Žižek and Miljana Cunta will speak at the opening ceremony of the 75th Frankfurter Buchmesse (17 October 2023). The philosopher, psychoanalyst and cultural critic Slavoj Žižek is one of the most prominent public intellectuals of our time. He teaches philosophy at the University of Ljubljana and the European Graduate School in Saas-Fee and is currently International Director of the Birkbeck Institute for the Humanities in London. His books (most recently *Too Late to Awaken: What Lies Ahead When There Is No Future?*, Allen Lane, 2023) and publications have been translated into more than 20 languages. Poet, translator and editor Miljana Cunta is the author of four volumes of poetry (most recently *Nekajkrat smo zašli, zdaj se vračamo* [A Few Times Lost, We Now Return], Slovenska matica, 2023). Her work has been nominated for Slovenia’s most important poetry awards. She has served as programme director at the international literary festivals in Vilenica and Fabula and has been a guest columnist for the major Slovenian daily newspaper *Delo*.

Guest of Honour Pavilion to show Slovenia's love of nature and sustainability

Inspired by the Guest of Honour motto "Honeycomb of Words", the Slovenian pavilion will be the venue for a wide-ranging exchange of ideas and for poetic voices. Two honeycomb-shaped auditoriums – named after the Slovenian poet Srečko Kosovel and author Maruša Krese – will host a diverse programme of poetry performances, author interviews and readings on all five days of the fair. For the first time, a Guest of Honour will be bringing 21st century tech issues to the Guest of Honour stages, thanks to its programme of compelling topics related to deep reading and AI. The international exhibition "Books on Slovenia" and its 400 titles will be located in the centre of the pavilion, along with oversized book installations and intriguing virtual features. Designed by Slovenian architecture firm Studio Sadar, the more than 2,000-square-metre Guest of Honour Pavilion (Forum, Level 1) is inspired by Slovenia's nature and consists of recycled materials that can be reused.

Major presence of Slovenian poetry

Poetry's special significance in Slovenia will also be evident in Frankfurt. Aleš Šteger, Cvetka Lipuš, Miljana Cunta, Brane Mozetič, Milan Dekleva, Barbara Korun and Ana Pepelnik are among the Slovenian poets who will put in an appearance in Frankfurt. On each day of the fair, the "Honey Hour", complete with a poem of the day, will open the programme at the Guest of Honour Pavilion. The poetry anthology *Mein Nachbar auf der Wolke* (My Neighbour on the Cloud) will be presented, along with works by renowned poets such as Srečko Kosovel, Maruša Krese and Tomaž Šalamun.

Focus on philosophy: Discussions with Slovenian intellectuals

This year's Guest of Honour will be bringing contemporary philosophers and psychoanalysts of the Ljubljana School to Frankfurt. Slavoj Žižek will provide insights at the book fair into his recent book *Surplus-Enjoyment*. During a philosophical debate at Goethe University, Slovenian intellectuals Slavoj Žižek, Alenka Zupančič and Mladen Dolar will engage with Frankfurt School theorists Rainer Forst and Martin Saar (20 October, 7.00 pm, Adorno Auditorium VI, Campus Bockenheimer).

Sports and literature

Professional sports and literature will also converge at the book fair: at the Guest of Honour Pavilion, Slovenian Olympic swimmer Sara Isakovič will explore whether a poem, play or novel can help an athlete train better. And UEFA President Aleksander Čeferin will talk with Frankfurter Buchmesse Director Juergen Boos about what writers can learn from sportspeople and vice versa.

Ljubljana Reading Manifesto

To what extent does reading promote analytic thinking? And how do the processes in the brain differ when someone reads a text on a piece of paper or on a computer screen? Slovenia will use several events to highlight the significance of higher-level and deep reading. Created in this

context, the Ljubljana Reading Manifesto has been signed by the International Publishers Association, the Federation of European Publishers, PEN International, the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions, and the German Academy for Language and Literature, and will be presented and discussed at the fair.

Artificial intelligence for texts and translations

In addition to reading and translating, the use of artificial intelligence for creating texts will be a key topic in Slovenia's programme. Author Maja Lunde, linguist Naomi Baron and others will join in the discussion. AI's role in translating texts will be explored by Darja Marinšek from the largest Slovenian publishing house Mladinska knjiga, Chris Mavergames from Wiley, and consultant and author Thad McIlroy.

Literature and culture programme in the city of Frankfurt

Some 30 renowned institutions in Frankfurt and throughout Germany will participate in the 2023 Guest of Honour's cultural programme. From art exhibitions and concerts, film screenings and readings to philosophical debates: numerous events and exhibitions will bring Slovenia's literature and culture to life beyond the book fair. For example, the Schirn Kunsthalle will be showing new works by visual artist Maruša Sagadin. On Thursday, the best-known Slovenian band, Laibach, will give an exclusive German concert with a literary theme in Frankfurt's Jahrhunderthalle (19 October, 8.00 pm). An exhibition in the Communications Museum will explore the history (and stories) of mobile phones in Slovenia and Germany. And with "Tweets from the Past", the Archaeological Museum will be inviting visitors to dive into sounds, symbols and writings from prehistoric, ancient and medieval Slovenia. The German Film Institute and Film Museum will be showing recent Slovenian short films, and the Fotografie Forum Frankfurt will present works by three contemporary Slovenian artists who experiment with photography and its boundaries.

Democratic, discursive and diverse: Politics at Frankfurter Buchmesse

Climate activist Lea Bonasera, Irina Scherbakova (Memorial) and many more

At a time when incomprehension is becoming increasingly prevalent in public discourse, Frankfurter Buchmesse offers a platform for democratic exchange. As a result, its cultural policy programme is focussing on the diversity of literature and its creators, and on providing a range of perspectives.

“The book fair is a democracy fair. Together with the German Publishers & Booksellers Association, we have been advocating for freedom of speech since 1949. This year, the presence of Salman Rushdie, who will receive the Peace Prize of the German Book Trade in Frankfurt on the last day of the fair, will lend the topic even greater weight and international visibility. Freedom of the press and freedom of expression are also being given considerable coverage in the programmes we curate ourselves,” says Torsten Casimir, spokesperson for Frankfurter Buchmesse.

Frankfurt Pavilion as a cultural policy stage

A large part of the cultural policy programme will take place in the iconic Frankfurt Pavilion located outdoors on the fair’s Agora. Panel members will include Claudia Roth, (Germany’s Federal Commissioner for Culture and the Media), Irina Scherbakova (author, co-founder of the human rights organisation Memorial), Dmitry Glukhovskiy (bestselling Russian author in exile) and Meron Mendel (Bildungsstätte Anne Frank). Organised together with Germany’s Federal Foreign Office, the Frankfurt Forum will take place in the pavilion and focus on the topic of democracy and human rights. There, Prof. Staffan Lindberg (Director of the V-Dem Institute, University of Gothenburg) will present the Democracy Report.

Human rights reading, Ukraine and fighters for the future

To mark the 75th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, international authors will read selected texts in their native languages. They will come from the book fair’s Guest of Honour countries, such as Slovenia, Italy and the Philippines. Under the motto “Fragility of Existence”, the Goethe-Institut Ukraine and the Ukrainian Book Institute will present Ukraine’s cultural sector at a 200-square-metre stand. As testimony to the crimes committed by the Third Reich, the exhibition “Scorched Places – Book Burnings of 1933” will be shown on the Agora. Photographs of today’s “scorched places” will be the focus of the exhibition, inviting viewers to engage with history. During “SHEROES – Streiterinnen für die Zukunft” (SHEROES – Fighters for the Future), broadcasters ARD, ZDF and 3sat will use their stage to present strong female

voices. Participants will include climate activist and Last Generation founder Lea Bonasera, former FEMEN activist Zana Ramadani, and AI expert and founder Mina Saidze. On the panel "Black Femininity - (New) Daughters of Africa", writer Bridget Minamore, translator Eleonore Wiedenroth-Coulibaly and researcher Dr Denise Bergold-Caldwell will talk about writing against the background of experiences of discrimination.

Opening of Frankfurter Buchmesse 2023 / Book industry's aim to play a role in strengthening democracy / Small publishing houses in particular at their limit due to economic pressure – structural support urgently needed to maintain diversity on the book market

Frankfurter Buchmesse opens its doors for the 75th time tomorrow. The book fair is a place of democracy par excellence, said Karin Schmidt-Friderichs, Chairwoman of the Börsenverein des Deutschen Buchhandels (German Publishers & Booksellers Association) at the press conference to mark the opening of the fair. "In the coming days, we will experience a multitude of stories, sentiments, inspiring ideas and opinions. Unlike any other institution, the book fair brings people from different countries together to talk peacefully about books and social issues."

This is of great importance given the many current crises. Schmidt-Friderichs: "We are deeply shocked by the Hamas terrorist attacks on Israel. We vehemently condemn this violence. Our sympathy goes to all the victims of the violence in Israel and Palestine. Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine, violating international law, has been raging on the edge of Europe now for a year and a half. Looking at Germany, we are concerned by the increase in popularity of extreme positions in society and the political party landscape. Debates are heating up; words are triggering waves of agitation. All around us, populism and nationalism are gaining ground at an alarming rate."

Basic democratic values are increasingly under attack, says Karin Schmidt-Friderichs. "Democracy, freedom and diversity are cornerstones of our society. We must defend them, as individuals, as an industry and as a society. The book industry can make a fundamental contribution to this. However, we need stable framework conditions in order to continue to perform this important role in the future."

A growing number of publishers and bookstores, authors, translators as well as the logistics sector of the industry are reaching their economic limits. At first glance, the current market figures are positive: Turnover in the central sales channels increased by four per cent in the first nine months of the year compared to the same period last year (source: Media Control). At the same time, however, 1.1 per cent fewer books were sold, and as much as 7.4 per cent fewer compared to the first three quarters of the pre-pandemic year 2019.

"The pandemic years of store closures and cancelled trade fairs, as well as the explosion in raw material and energy costs, are threatening the economic existence of small, independent publishing houses in particular. These publishers play a decisive role in shaping the diversity of the book market by offering titles outside the mainstream and discovering new titles and writers. Politicians and society must ask themselves: What is a diverse book landscape worth to us? We urgently need structural support for publishers. There is a need for action here to quickly implement the ideas from the coalition agreement and to include the necessary funds in the federal budget," said Karin Schmidt-Friderichs.

Furthermore, the visibility of books in the media is fundamental for the industry and society: "Books and discourse surrounding them are vital building blocks in our culture of debate. It is one of the central tasks of public broadcasting to provide a space for such debates. Therefore, books need a proper platform here too – contemporary, also on new, non-linear (on-demand) channels – but also in linear programming and in formats that are familiar and accessible to the public. Those responsible in the media should keep this in mind with regard to upcoming transformations," says Schmidt-Friderichs.
