

Booking of Signing tents Terms of contract

Your entry in Frankfurter Buchmesse's reservation/booking tool is considered a binding order. As part of this entry, various mandatory details are required, including the venue/stage, start and end of the event, content and type of event, as well as participants and event participants (speakers, authors, presenters, etc.).

However, the entry does not constitute the conclusion of a contract. You will receive a written or electronic order confirmation (PDF file) from us after a positive review, which represents the conclusion of the contract.

Frankfurter Buchmesse reserves the right to reject events that do not fit into the programme's content concept or if it has reason to believe that the event may jeopardise the smooth running of the fair or security. In case that your event is rejected, you will receive notification that we are unable to admit your event. Furthermore, Frankfurter Buchmesse reserves the right to make the booking of stages and venues dependent on a security deposit.

The use of the stages and venues is limited to the event purposes and descriptions stated in the order confirmation, in particular taking into account the capacity limits stated. Frankfurter Buchmesse must be notified immediately of any changes to the event, in particular in the area of the compulsory details mentioned. Corresponding changes entitle Frankfurter Buchmesse to re-examine the order.

The slots that can be booked on the stages and venues are intended to offer an attractive programme and fit into the content concept of Frankfurter Buchmesse's programme and the individual stages. We therefore reserve the right to cancel or reschedule booked slots due to changed circumstances, even after an order confirmation has been issued. This applies in particular if the information you have provided about the event is incomplete or incorrect, or if it becomes apparent when you specify or change information about the event that it is not compatible with the concept in terms of content, or if there is reason to believe that the event could endanger the smooth running or safety of Frankfurter Buchmesse. If necessary, you will also be asked to postpone a booked slot and/or to switch to a stage that is more suitable for your event. This applies in particular in the event that compliance with capacity limits applicable to individual stages and venues cannot be guaranteed. In any case, we reserve the right to limit access to an event for capacity or safety reasons. The corresponding assessment is at the discretion of Frankfurter Buchmesse.

Cancellation of your booked slot is possible at any time. To do so, please contact stages@buchmesse.de in writing. In the event of cancellation before 26 August 2022, cancellation fees amounting to 20 per cent of the event price will be incurred; from 26 August 2022, the cancellation fees will amount to 100 per cent of the event price. In case that an event has to be cancelled by Frankfurter Buchmesse, the exhibitor will be reimbursed for any event fees already paid, unless the exhibitor has culpably caused the cancellation, e.g. by providing incorrect or incomplete information; in this case, Frankfurter Buchmesse can demand payment of the event fee as compensation, insofar as it was no longer possible for the event slot to be filled elsewhere.

In order to ensure the smooth running and security of the respective event and of the fair as a whole, it is necessary for the exhibitor and any security personnel commissioned by the exhibitor to

cooperate closely with Frankfurter Buchmesse and its security forces and to provide the latter with all information relevant to the event and security. Upon request, Frankfurter Buchmesse must be informed of all advertising activities planned and carried out by the exhibitor in connection with the booked event. We would like to point out that the general public, including the press, is admitted to all events on the stages and venues booked. All contractual relations between the parties shall be governed by German law to the exclusion of the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods. The place of jurisdiction for all disputes is - as far as legally permissible - Frankfurt am Main.
