# Logging in My Book Fair

You can register as a trade visitor or exhibitor in three simple steps.

Enter the following
URL into the address bar
of your browser:
https://services.buchmesse.de/login/external

Click on "Register now".

#### You don't have a My Book Fair profile yet?

#### Trade visitors register to...

- buy a trade visitor ticket
- redeem a ticket code or link (trade visitor tickets and exhibitor tickets)
- · use the matchmaking tool

#### Exhibitors register to...

- · update your company profile in the Exhibitor Directory
- · gain access to the exhibitor ticket portal
- book a slot in a signing box
- · publish your events in the Calendar of Events
- settle your invoices via credit card.

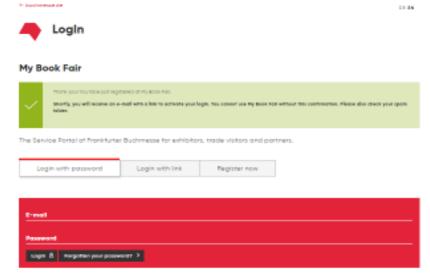

# Creating and sending ticket codes and ticket links



**Exhibitor ticket portal** 

Ticket managers of exhibiting companies can create fair tickets here, as well as distribute and manage them.



Please log in to your My Book Fair account with the email address you have on file with us as ticket manager.

Then click on "Tickets" and on "Exhibitor Ticket Portal".







Please click on the stand you would like to use to send ticket codes and/or links.

You can see from the gift symbol whether you have free tickets.







To create an **exhibitor pass**, please click on "Issue Exhibitor Passes" at the bottom of the "Exhibitor Passes" overview.

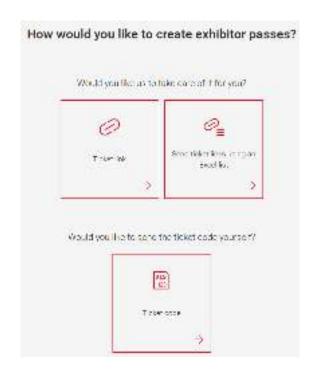


Now you can choose whether you would like to create **ticket links** or **ticket codes**.

**Ticket links** can be sent directly to your colleagues' e-mail address.

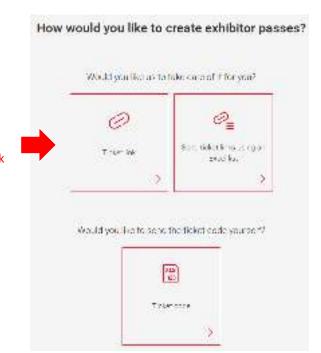
Whereas **ticket codes** will be sent to your e-mail address and can be sent individually afterwards.

If you have to issue a larger number of ticket links, you can also upload an Excel list containing the recipients' e-mail addresses.





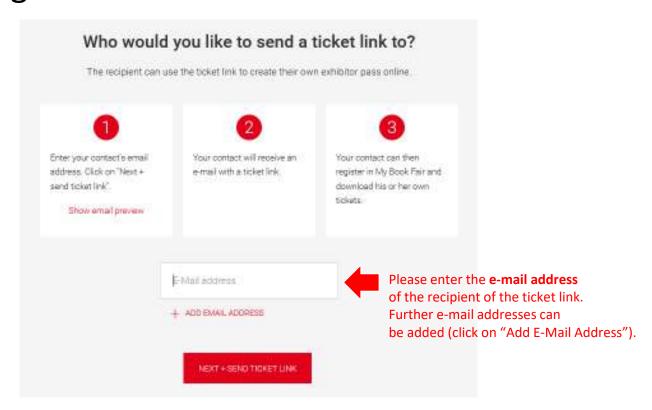
#### Sending ticket links

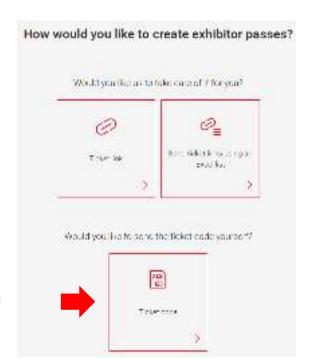


After sending the link(s), you are taken to an **overview page** where you can see all the tickets you have sent, to whom, and whether they've been claimed or not.

The recipient of the link will receive an e-mail. Clicking on the link will take the user to their ticket, after they log in to My Book Fair.

Attention: In order to redeem a ticket, each recipient needs to have their own My Book Fair account.





If you want to send ticket codes only, simply click on "Ticket code".









You will now return to the overview page. Under Ticket No. you will see the requested ticket code. You can now pass this on to the recipients to redeem in their accounts.

You will also receive the requested ticket codes by e-mail.



After ordering the ticket codes, you will receive an email with a **download link**. Click on the link to download the excel sheet containing the codes.

Please note: The download is available two weeks upon receipt. After that date, you can copy the ticket codes from your overview in the Exhibitor Ticket Portal.

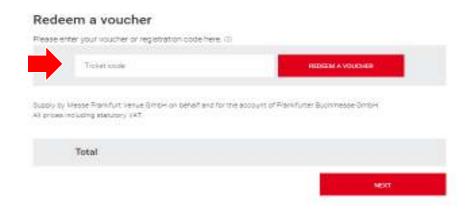


# Redeeming and retrieving tickets









You can now redeem your ticket code here or redeem a ticket code for someone else.

**Please mind:** Only trade visitor tickets and exhibitor tickets can be redeemed in My Book Fair, <u>not</u> private visitor tickets.

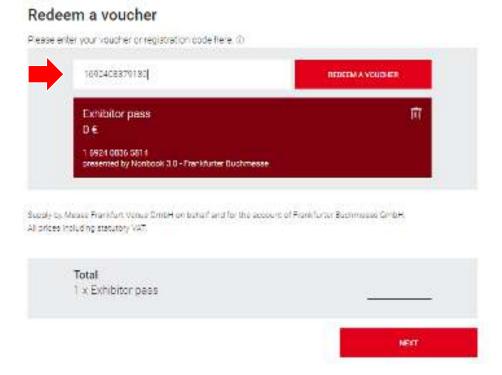
Private visitor codes are redeemed in the private visitor shop <u>not</u> in My Book Fair.

Please enter the ticket codes you would like to convert and click on "Redeem youcher code".

Then please click on "continue".



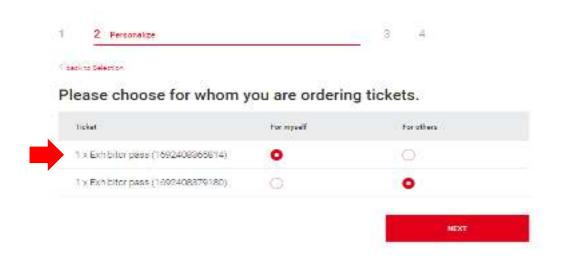

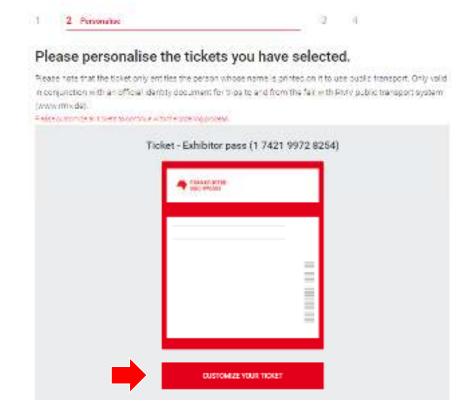
#### Redeeming a ticket code

Please select whether the ticket is for you or for someone else and then click on "continue".

If the ticket is for another person, they <u>do not</u> need their own My Book Fair account, just their own email address.





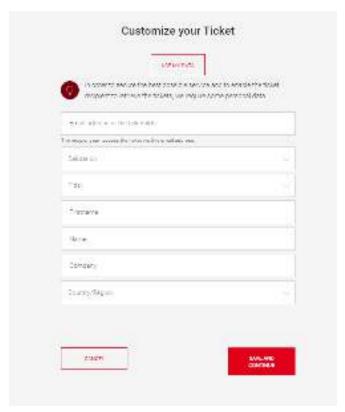


Please customize your ticket now.



Now you can enter the data of the person who needs a ticket or you can personalize the ticket with your data by clicking on "Use my data".

If the ticket is for another person, they do not need their own My Book Fair account, just their own email address.





Please check your entries now. You can change them again by clicking on the small pencil symbol on the right or discard them by clicking on the bin symbol.

Please click on "Send order" and do not forget to accept the general terms and conditions.



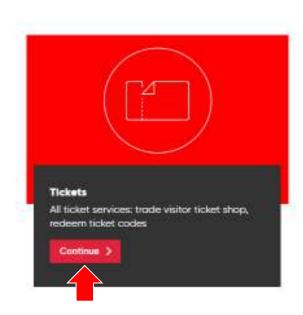
You will now receive your redeemed ticket by email and can also access it in your My Book Fair account.

If you have redeemed a ticket code for another person, the person will receive the ticket by email. You will also receive the same ticket by email and can forward it to the person again if necessary.



#### Retrieve tickets

To retrieve your ticket, you can also log into your My Book Fair account. Then please click on "Tickets"

Please click on "Retrieve ticket". Here you can now print out your ticket or show it online.

# Free contingent and managing further tickets

Maybe you were given tickets or ordered them along with your stand. How and where to see your contingent and how additional tickets are billed will be explained on the following pages.



#### Free contingent



#### **Settlement with free quota:**

In the screenshot, 5 tickets have already been allocated and two of the recipients have already redeemed the ticket.

This overview shows issued, registered and used tickets as well as the amount of allotted tickets.

This overview shows If one of these 5 tickets is now used to enter the fair, this ticket issued, registered will be offset against the free quota (250 tickets).

If you have used up your free ticket quota but a colleague still needs a ticket, you can buy another one. The invoice will be sent to you at the end of the fair. You will only be charged for the tickets that were actually used.



Usually, one e-mail address is stored in the system as the ticket manager. The person with this e-mail and My Book Fair account is the ticket manager. In order to let several users to carry out tasks in the Exhibitor Ticket Portal, the Ticket Manager must appoint representatives/proxies.

A representative can then perform the same tasks as the Ticket Manager.





On the overview page for your stand, please click the "edit symbol" (pencil) in the top row of the page.



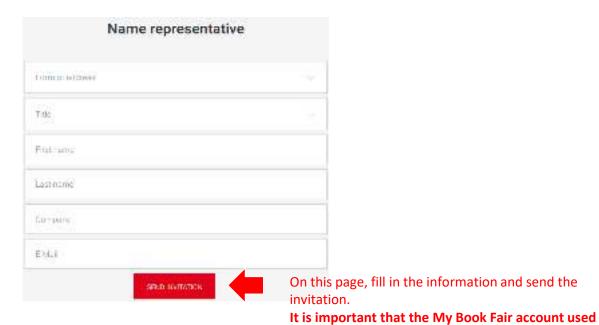




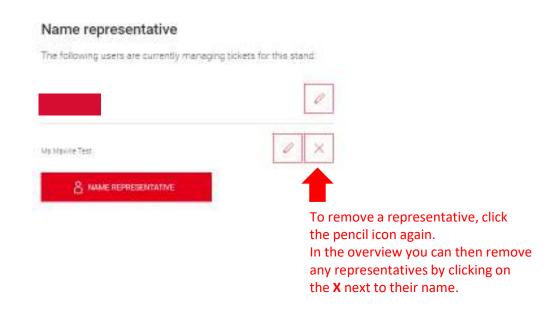

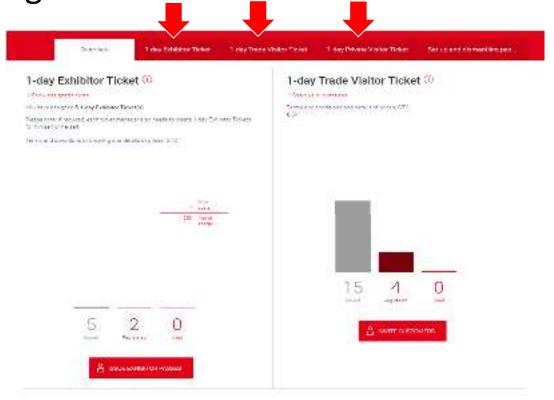


### Blocking tickets

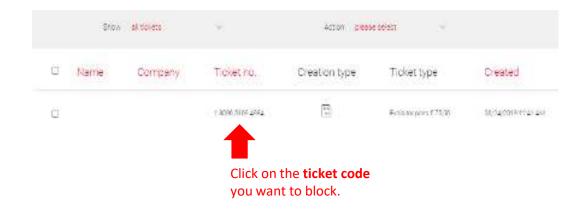

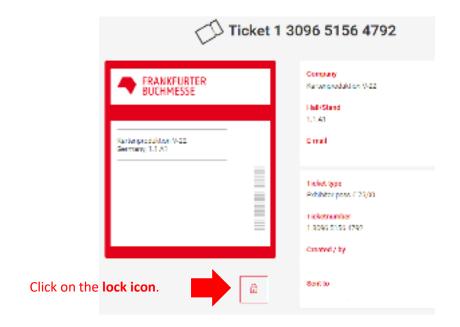


If you want to lock a ticket, please click on the ticket type you want to lock.
